He also introduced the newly developed Course File Management Portal, which has been integrated into the University EMS as a sub-menu under the OBE module, facilitating systematic and digital management of course files.

Prof. Dr. Hasan further discussed various policies and guidelines related to the preparation, maintenance, and standardization of different course file components, ensuring consistency and compliance with institutional quality assurance requirements. During the seminar, the Honorable Vice Chancellor, Prof. Dr. Asraf Ali,

As part of the promotional initiative, the department also distributed its departmental academic calendar, enhancing visibility and strengthening connections with local academic institutions.

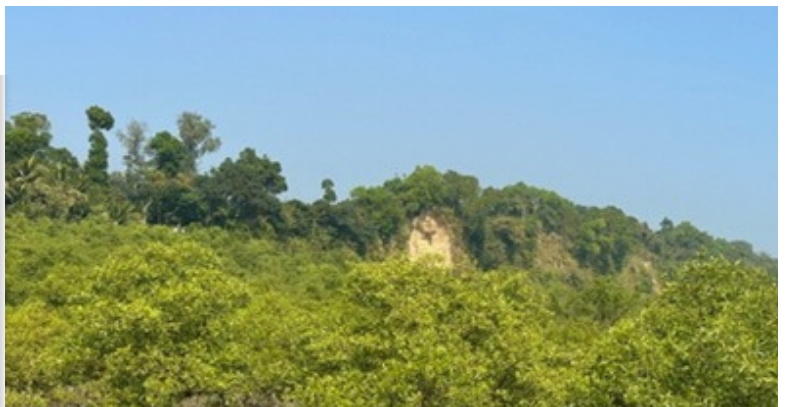


The outreach program generated strong enthusiasm among students and reinforced KYAU's growing leadership in microbiology education within the region.

Office of the Controller of Examinations

Result Publication: Summer Semester 2025

The Final Examinations of the Summer Semester 2025 were held from 23 November 2025 to 15 December 2025. The results were published on 04 January 2026 and subsequently approved in the 25th Academic Council Meeting held on 03 February 2026.

A total of 1,655 students appeared in the examinations, among whom 1,354 students successfully passed. Notably, 47 students achieved a perfect GPA of 4.00 out of 4.00. A total of 169 students completed their graduation in the Summer Semester 2025.
